

Welcome to our home.

Feel free to use anything you find in here while staying. There are plenty of movies to watch, games to play, books to read, and Christian CD's to listen to. Please make sure you leave all those things here when you leave so that the next guest will be able to enjoy them too.

*The location is 1607 Shafter with the entrance to the apartment by means of the alley just to the west of Shafter Street.

*We ask for payment in advance prior to arrival. Please make your check or money order for the use of the apartment payable to **Jody Fauley**. You may mail them in to Whole Person Counseling, 342 South Chadbourne, San Angelo, Texas 76903.

*This is a very quiet neighborhood, so we ask that you keep the noise level down while here.

*Our dog's name is Dixie. She may bark at you when you come and go, but she is very sweet & sleeps in our house at night. Let us know if she is a problem.

*Please refrain from smoking while inside. There is a covered carport or outside area you can use if you do smoke.

*Since the bedroom has a full-size bed, with a twin sleeper in the living room, we feel that 2 adults w/one child is the maximum number of people who will comfortably fit for an extended period of time.

*The garbage man picks up trash on Tuesday and Friday a.m. Make sure your vehicle is under the carport so that you do not block his path. Place your trash in one of the garbage cans behind our home if needed.

*All appliances, heating/cooling, plumbing, and electrical are in good working condition. However, if something does happen, please contact us at (325) 650-8949. If it is an emergency and you are unable to reach us, contact our handyman, Bobby Knight, at (325) 655-2696. We do have a toddler, so we ask that you not contact us after 9 p.m. or before 8 a.m. unless it is an emergency.

*There is a small space heater and fan in the bathroom for you to use (depending on what the weather outside is like). Please turn them off before leaving for the day. Extra light bulbs, tissue, and toilet paper are located in the storage baskets above the sink in the bathroom.

*The house is heated by the wall unit in the living room. The control for it is on the wall by the side door in the kitchen. Adjust it as needed for your comfort.

*There are ceiling fans in both rooms. The house is cooled by the window unit in the living room.

*The living room light/ceiling fan is controlled by a remote kept by the front door. There is also a porch light for you to use if you come and go at night.

*We have included a list of places to eat, shop, wash clothes, entertainment, and their proximity to the apartment.

*There is no phone service in the apartment, so you will need to bring a cell phone with you. If you do not have a cell phone, there is a convenience store close by that has a pay phone. We do not have cable in the apartment at this time. You are welcome to use the movies we provide or bring ones of your own if you want to watch TV.

*There are a few food items in the pantry/fridge that you are welcome to use. You might want to make a trip to HEB after settling in to stock up on the items you need during your stay.

*There is a hamper in the closet. If you wish to change the sheets during your stay, the extra set is in the chest of drawers. Just place the dirty sheets in the hamper. There should be plenty of towels/wash cloths for you while you are here.

*When you leave, please strip the sheets from the bed & place them in the hamper with any dirty towels. All dishes should be placed in the sink or dishwasher. Any food left in the refrigerator will be thrown away. Lock the door and place the key in the small mailbox located under the carport.
