out of the mouth of God."

Some Methods for Memorization and Meditation

- 1. Write the verse down on a 3 X 5 card and read through it 5 times in the morning and 5 times in the evening for seven days.
- 2. Illustrate the verse by doodling:



- 3. Diagram the sentence to discover at the parts: subject, verb, direct object, etc.
- 4. Meditation is like the sheep which belches up the food and chews the cud to get all the nutrients out of it.
- 5. Meditation is like taking a diamond and holding up to the light to see each of the facets.

If you memorized just one verse each week, you would memorize 52 verses in one year.
