(Jeremiah 17:7). I have been translated from the kingdom of darkness into the kingdom of God's Son.

U = I am <u>understood</u> by Jesus in my suffering. (Philippians 2:7-8, Hebrews 2:18). I have <u>unsearchable</u> riches in Christ. (Ephesians 3:8).

V = I am <u>victorious</u> because Jesus had victory over sin and the world. (I Corinthians 15:57). I can hear and follow the <u>voice</u> of Jesus. (John 10:27).

W = I have been <u>washed</u> in the blood of Jesus and made <u>white</u> as snow. (Isaiah 1:18, Revelation 7:14). I am God's <u>workmanship</u>, created to do good works. (Ephesians 2:10).

 $\mathbf{X} = I$ am crucified (\underline{X}) with Christ, but also live with him. (Galatians 2:20).

 $\mathbf{Y} = I$ have <u>yielded</u> my life to Jesus as my Lord. (Romans 12:1-2, 6:13). I <u>yearn</u> to live in the presence of the Lord. (Psalms 42:1).

 $\mathbf{Z} = I$ have the <u>zeal</u> of the Lord. (Titus 2:14).

Overcoming

REJECTION

When David returned with his men from battle, they found that their city had been burned and that their wives and children had been taken captives. Although David had been their faithful leader in battle, David's men were so disappointed, discouraged, and depressed that they spoke of killing David. David not only faced the loss of his home and his two wives, he also faced the <u>rejection</u> by his own men. David, himself, became very distressed; however he <u>encouraged</u> himself. (I Samuel 30:1-6).

Although the Scripture does not specifically tell us at this point how David encouraged himself, he often encouraged himself with the promises that God had given to him. As a Believer, you can also encourage yourself.

The following exercise using the Alphabet may help you to encourage yourself as you face disappointment, REJECTION, and depression:

 $\mathbf{A} = \mathbf{I}$ am <u>adopted</u> as a child of God.

(Ephesians 1:5). I am <u>accepted</u> in the Beloved. (Ephesians 1:6).

 $\mathbf{B} = I$ am spiritually <u>born</u> again. (I Peter 1:23). I am <u>blessed</u> with all spiritual blessings. (Ephesians 1:3).

C = I am <u>chosen</u> by God. (I Peter 2:9). I am <u>comforted</u> by the Holy Spirit. (John 14:16). I am <u>cared</u> for by God, Himself. (I Peter 5:7).

 $\mathbf{D} = I \text{ am } \underline{\text{delivered}}$ from the powers of darkness. (Colossians 1:13). I have God's <u>divine</u> nature living in me. (II Peter 1:4).

 \mathbf{E} = I have the gift of <u>eternal life</u>. (John 10:28). I am <u>engraved</u> in the palms of God's hands. (Isaiah 49:16). I have received an <u>earnest</u> of the Spirit. (II Corinthians 1:22).

 $\mathbf{F} = I$ am <u>forgiven</u> of all my sins. (I John 2:12). I will never be <u>forsaken</u>. (Hebrew 13:5). I am a <u>friend</u> of God. (John 15:15).

G = I have God's <u>goodness</u> following me all the days of my life. (Psalms 23:6) I have been given <u>grace</u> to live as a Believer. (I Corinthians 15:10). $\mathbf{H} = I$ have <u>help</u> in time of need. (Hebrew 4:16). I am a <u>heir</u> of God and a joint-heir with Christ. (Romans 8:17). I am <u>healed</u> by His stripes. (I Peter 2:24). I have a <u>home</u> in Heaven. (John 14:2-3).

I = I am born of the <u>incorruptible</u> seed by the word of God. (I Peter 1:23). I have an <u>inner</u> man that is renewed day by day. (II Corinthians 4:16).

J = I am justified (just as though I have never sinned) by my faith in Jesus. (Romans 5:1). I have the joy of the Lord. (John 15:11).

 $\mathbf{K} = I$ am <u>kept</u> by His faithfulness. (II Timothy 1:12, 2:13). I am made a <u>king</u> unto the Lord in His kingdom. (Revelation 1:6).

L = I am <u>loved</u> by God with an everlasting love. (Jeremiah 31:3, John 3:16). I have <u>life</u> because I believe in Jesus. (John 6:47).

 $\mathbf{M} = I$ receive God's <u>mercy</u> every day. (Lamentations 3:22-23). I am <u>more</u> than a conqueror through God's love. (Romans 8:37). I will not be <u>moved</u> because the LORD is at my right hand. (Psalms 16:8). N = I am a <u>new</u> creature in Christ. (II Corinthians 5:17, Ephesians 4:24). I am <u>needed</u> as part of the body of Christ. (Ephesian 4:16).

 $\mathbf{O} = I$ am <u>owned</u> by the Creator. (Psalm 100:3). (I Corinthians 6:19). I am an <u>overcomer</u>. (I John 5:4-5). I am not left as an <u>orphan</u>. (John 14:18).

 $\mathbf{P} = I$ am made <u>perfect</u> (complete) in the spirit. (Hebrew 10:14). I am <u>purchased</u> by the blood of Christ. (Acts 20:28). I am <u>protected</u> by God. (Romans 8:31).

Q = I am <u>quickened</u> (made alive) by the Spirit of Christ. (Ephesian 2:5). I have a <u>quiet</u> spirit. (I Peter 3:4).

 $\mathbf{R} = I$ am made <u>righteous</u> though the suffering of Jesus. (II Corinthians 5:21). I <u>reign</u> in this life by God's grace. (Romans 5:17).

S = I am <u>saved</u> by His grace. (Ephesians 2:8-9). I have been <u>sanctified</u> by the work of Christ. (I Corinthians 6:11). I am a <u>servant</u> to the Most High God. (Romans 6:22).

 $\mathbf{T} = I$ am <u>taught</u> by the Holy Spirit. (John 14:26). I <u>trust</u> in the Lord.
