


## May I Ask You A Question?


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
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The most important question that someone can ask you is not

• "Where do you go to church?" or "How much money do you make?" or "What is your nationality?" or "How much education do you have?"

Before we ask the question, let's look at a basis for the question.



We need to understand that God made man in His image as a three dimensional person (body, soul, and spirit). Like a seed, we have an outer shell called the body. The purpose of the body is for physical awareness. Within the body we have what the Bible calls the **soul** (mind, will, and emotions). The purpose of the soul is self awareness.


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## What We Believe

Ephesians 4:8-16. \* Everyone has the freedom in the Spirit to worship the Lord. Psalms 134:1-2, 138:1, 47:1, 150:1-6. \* Believers are encouraged to minister according to their spiritual gifts. Romans 12:6-8, I Corinthians 12:1-12, I Peter 4:10-11

**spirit** for the purpose of having a relationship with God. God looks at us from the inside out. “And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ” (1 Thessalonians 5:23). **However**, something has happened to the spirit of man that keeps him from having a personal relationship with God ...

This means that we all have disobeyed God (all have sinned). **Romans 3:10** "As it is written, There is none righteous, no, not one." **Romans 3:23** "For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God." It is not just an overt action, but what comes from inside the heart. "For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders, thefts,



### 2. The penalty for sin is death.

**Romans 5:12** "Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned:"

**(Genesis 2:17** "But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die.") This means that man becomes dead in his spirit and can not have a relation-



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
Jesus also said, in **John 7:37-38**, "In the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink. He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly (inner most being) shall flow rivers of living water."

3. Jesus paid the penalty for our sin.

To resolve this problem, God sent his son Jesus into world. Jesus lived a perfect life, then died on the cross taking our penalty upon himself. **Romans 5:8** "But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us." **Isaiah 53:6** "All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all."

4. We must accept Jesus (make a faith commitment) as our Lord and Saviour.

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
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**Here is the BIG important QUESTION.**

**“Have you ever at any time in your life given your life to Jesus allowing Him to become your Lord. & Saviour?”,**


If you can **not** answer this question with, "YES", please stop and

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

**I Peter 1:23** "Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever." Even though we (in the soul) may think wrong thoughts, get angry when we shouldn't and become disobedient, these things will not corrupt the spirit-man or new creation.

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

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
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

My Father, which gave them me, is greater than all; and no *man* is able to pluck them out of my Father's hand."




Absolutely nothing can take us out of the hands of God because this new life is a gift of God.

6. We need to distinguish between the soul and spirit.

We need to understand that there is a big difference between the soul and the spirit. The change takes place in the spirit-man. **Hebrews 4:12** "For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a disincerter of the thoughts and intents of the heart."



7. We need to understand that the new man (creation) is not capable of being corrupted.

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
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
